



Opportunity

Integrated service for storing slideshows in the cloud and enabling live anonymous posting of questions relating to content of lecture.

Function

Glisser allows for lecturer(s) to upload and store slideshow in the cloud. Anonymous question service is superimposed on top the slideshow service.

Use

Glisser allows lecturer(s) to upload slideshows to a cloud service (max 5 slideshows in the free plan). Slideshow(s) are available after logging into the service, effectively eliminating the need for USB-sticks. The service superimposes a 'post questions' service on top the slideshow. Students and participants can also follow the slideshow on their individual device while at the same being able anonymously and silently post questions during the presentation. The posed questions are made available instantly to all participants logged in at the same time, enabling for participants to vote for the question(s) they find the most relevant. The results are made available to the lecturer and can be accessed and presented on the public screen; displaying the questions being stacked in the order of most received votes. Fits well with a shorter/longer Q&A-session.

Tech 1-2-3

1. Lecturer(s) registers an account on Glisser.com
2. Lecturer uploads the slideshow to the Glisser service. The slideshow is made available from any login location. After clicking 'Present' on the right, the slideshow is made available in a new Internet-window. It looks and acts as usual, but also displays a link that participants may log in to on their device (by providing their e-mail address). A 'thumbnail' version of the slideshow is available on the device (useful in large lecture halls where the visibility of the text might be poor in the back).
3. Students can post questions on the content on their device. All submitted questions are made available immediately to all participants, enabling for the participants to vote 'silently' and anonymously to their favorite question(s). Towards the end of the session the lecturer may access the result of the question posting by clicking on the icon with three dots (on the pop-up navigation bar made available to the right of the presentation screen).
