



Opportunity

Live survey tool for classroom. Students vote via mobile device.

Function

Enables individual lecturer(s) to conduct 'live surveys' with instant presentation on projector.

Use

Live surveys are tools to connect covered topics with students' point of views. The submission is anonymous and enables instant visualization. As an example: a lecture on macroeconomics covering strengths and weaknesses of 'common currency areas' could create an instant survey to get students' point of view on the topic. Anonymous submission of answers discourages group-think phenomena and the effects of 'strong voices' in classroom.

A quick way to get started is to end the first 45 minutes of lecturing with a survey that students respond to during the break. After the break, the result of the survey is projected on the screen in the classroom. Different visualization options are available, e.g. bar charts, rankings, free text, word clouds etc.

Tech 1-2-3

1. Lecturer(s) registers an account on polleverywhere.com
2. Lecturer creates a new survey and format of survey. Survey library is available, but only one active survey at a time are allowed. Make sure it is set to **active** (small icon with mobile and three arrows pointing to devices). Click the link of the survey to set the projector screen to 'live publication' mode.
3. The 'live publication' screen shows a web link that the students and participants enter into their device to submit their answer. The submission is visualized immediately on the projector screen. Max 40 submissions of answers is the limit in the free plan.
